



THE FAB SHOP PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION TO CARPENTRY FOR YOUTH

Tradeworks is offering a 26 week Essential Skills & Carpentry Training Program for young people who are not currently in the work force.

Participants will receive an allowance of \$8/hour for skill building hours. Participants will have six weeks in a hands-on project learning where they will be taught essential workplace skills, shop safety, carpentry math, the use of hand & power tools, and the basics of residential construction and joinery.

Participants will receive up to \$9.50/hr for an additional 20 weeks of work experience in a production facility where they will continue as they hone their employability skills while producing wood products for general market use.

At the conclusion of the program, graduates will be assisted in finding employment elsewhere or continued education. Successful students will be ready to pursue a carpentry apprenticeship.

PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18 – 30 years old at time of intake.
- In need of assistance to overcome employment barriers.
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person on whom refugee status can be conferred.
- Currently not in school.
- Not eligible to receive Employment Insurance benefits.
- Personal issues related to substance abuse must be in a minimum of middle recovery.
- Be able to read and understand signs, labels and lists.
- Be able to work in a class with fifteen other students.
- Be in good health and physically able to perform work.
